Statement of Policy

Governors are volunteers' and members of the local community who freely give up their own time to support both Claypole Church of England Primary School and the children and staff who are part of the school community as well as the wider community.

It is the view of the governing body that since they are volunteers **no** remuneration will be provided by the school for normal day to day duties (e.g. attending governing body meetings or visiting the school).

However, travelling expenses for attending training courses / briefings / meetings outside the immediate locality of the school may be paid. An example would be a training course or meeting in Lincoln or Sleaford. In this circumstance mileage would be paid at the normal Lincolnshire County Council rate.

Governors are able to use our out of school facilities free of charge if they are taking part in governor related activities / duties.
